

2018 IN-HAND CHAMPIONSHIP, DARTMOOR HILL PONY.

1. Unhitch pole from A, lead pony through between A and B, hitch pole back on A. TIME STARTS AS YOU LIFT POLE FROM A.
2. Lead in and out of cones. Touch any cone, 10 secs added for each touch.
3. PULL BOX OF APPLES from 3, round yellow flag and return box to 3. ANY APPLES THAT FALL FROM THE BOX MUST BE REPLACED BEFORE CONTINUING.
4. At 4 REVERSE BETWEEN THE HURDLES, TURN PONY AT X and LEAD FORWARD OVER SEASAW.
5. The pony must be led onto the SEASAW with the handler leading alongside, but NOT on the SEASAW. If the pony comes off the SEASAW before the end, 10 (ten) seconds will be added to the overall time. If after 30 seconds the pony has not set a foot (hoof) on the seasaw, the judge will send the pony on to the rest of the course, and one minute will be added to the overall time.
6. LEAD through the SQUARE BETWEEN THE FLAGS. Please note there will be several empty water carriers hanging at the entrance. Any pony refusing to enter the SQUARE, will be allowed 30 seconds of hesitation, after which rule 5 will apply.
7. Back pony through uprights after removing white pole. White pole must be replaced before continuing.
8. Lead in and out of TRAILER, 10 seconds allowed for hesitation, after rule for 5 applies.
9. THE FINISH, as the start unhitch pole from A, lead pony through between A and B, then hitch pole back on A. Time stops as you release pole.
